
**Studio:** Up to 14 yogis; ideal for small groups and intimate sessions

#### Small local plane (Fly Sansa)

By Air + Shuttle:

30-minute flight to Limón

Shuttle to Samasati: ~45 minutes | \$22 per person

Total time: ~1.5 hours from landing

## 4 – 6 hour scenic drive with local food along the way

By Shuttle or Taxi:

Scenic 4.5-hour drive from San José

Shuttle: \$65 per person | Private taxi: \$250 (up to 3 people)

# Caring for Yourself and the Land

About Your Belongings:

The rainforest is humid. Avoid bringing delicate fabrics or leather.

Limit electronics; moisture can be damaging



**About Water:** 

Samasati water is from the mountain and catchment-based and sacred
Bring a reusable water bottle
Safe filtered drinking water is available throughout the property



All meals are vegetarian by default Chicken and fish available for an added cost We accommodate most dietary needs—just let us know in advance





## What to Expect on the Mountain

- Samasati sits atop a lush mountain ridge—just 5–10 minutes from our gate, but a world away from distractions
- The road is rugged—but the view is worth every bump
- The beach is only 20 minutes away Important Tips:
- A flashlight is essential—it gets dark early in the jungle
- Power outages happen; rooms have safety lighting
- Meals, yoga, and events continue by candlelight when needed
- Fiber-optic internet available in the restaurant & half the property
- •• Bring binoculars—wildlife is everywhere!






# Your Essential Retreat Packing List

Water-resistant Day Bag – For your flashlight, water, camera, phone

- 2+ Bathing Suits One will always be drying
- Waterproof Bags & Ziplocks For all clothes & electronics
- Hiking Shoes + Extra Socks Trails are gorgeous but can be slick
- ♣ Rain Gear It's the rainforest. Expect rain.
- Reusable Water Bottle Clean, filtered water is always available
- Sandals for the Beach Flip-flops OK, or hiking sandals
- Natural Bug Repellent Citronella, peppermint, lavender
- Cozy Clothes for Cool Nights Long sleeves, soft pants, socks
- Journal, Sketchpad, Books Bring your tools in ziplocks
- Flashlight Smartphone is OK, but a real one is better
- Reef-Safe Sunscreen Protect yourself and the ocean
